### **SPEED LIMIT CHANGES ON THE WAY AT GLENORIE**

Safety will be improved for motorists at Glenorie with changes to speed limits along Whites Road and Boronia Road at Glenorie from late June.

Member for Hawkesbury Robyn Preston MP said Roads and Maritime Services carried out a speed zone review after requests from the community to reduce speed limits on these roads.

“Roads and Maritime will be installing a 60 km/h speed limit along Whites Road and Boronia Road to provide more consistent journeys for all motorists,” Ms Preston said.

“The speed limit is being reduced from 100 km/h to 60 km/h on Whites Road and Boronia Road between Old Northern Road and the end of Boronia Street at the cul-de-sac.”

Ms Preston said the speed limit is expected to provide significant road safety benefits to residents and all road users in the area.

“The changes to the speed limits were assessed on a number of factors including crash history, road geometry, road environment and traffic volumes,” she said.

“Motorists are reminded to drive to sign posted speed limits at all times for the safety of all road users.”

The changes to the speed limit will come into effect when new speed limit signs are installed from Thursday 20 June, weather permitting.
