\$53,000 FOR FLOOD MANAGEMENT IN HAWKESBURY

Member for Hawkesbury, Robyn Preston MP today welcomed new funding of \$53,000 to Hawkesbury City Council for local floodplain management through the NSW Government's Floodplain Management Grants Program.

Ms Preston said the grant, awarded under the 2019-20 Floodplain Management Program, will help Hawkesbury City Council better understand and manage local flood levels, risk and exposure in the Hawkesbury electorate.

"I congratulate Hawkesbury City Council on successfully securing this money to support their plans for the Review of Hawkesbury floodplain risk management study and plan 2012.

"This new regional flood study will provide the most up-to-date flood information for the Hawkesbury-Nepean Valley based on current modelling techniques," Ms Preston said.

The Government's Floodplain Management Grants Program funds important projects for local councils to assess flood risk and help reduce flood impacts on their local communities.

The grants assist with flood studies and flood risk management studies, as well as the implementation of works to reduce flood risk such as flood levees, flood gates, warning systems, house raising or purchase in high risk areas.

In 2019-2020 under the Floodplain Management Grants Program \$7.26 million for 50 projects will enable local Councils, County Councils and other government bodies with floodplain risk management responsibilities to undertake priority projects.
