INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS AT RICHMOND NOW COMPLETE

Motorists travelling through the March and Bosworth streets intersection at Richmond will experience smoother, more reliable journeys with improvements to the busy junction now complete.

Member for Hawkesbury, Robyn Preston MP, said the Australian and NSW government funded project has improved traffic flow, reduced congestion for motorists and increased amenity for active transport users in the area.

“Transport for NSW has recently carried out a suite of upgrades to the March and Bosworth streets intersection at Richmond, which has become a busy junction in the area,” Ms Preston said.

“The upgrades have not only reduced congestion, they have also boosted safety for motorists, cyclists and pedestrians and improved access for freight and other heavy vehicles.

“A new dedicated right turn bay has been built on March Street for eastbound motorists turning right into Bosworth Street and new signs and traffic signals have been installed so westbound motorists can no longer turn right on to Bosworth Street from March Street.

“The No Stopping and restricted parking zones on both sides of March Street between Chapel and Bosworth streets were extended to increase capacity and improve traffic flow, and a new footpath on March Street was installed to improve amenity for pedestrians.”
