FUNDING FOR CATTAI PUBLIC SCHOOL ROAD ENTRANCE AND CAR PARK

The students and parents of Cattai Public School were excited to start the school year with a newly sealed school entrance roadway and car park.

Member for Hawkesbury, Robyn Preston MP welcomed the sealing of the entry way to the school saying that this funding was well received by the community as the unsealed roadway was unacceptable and in desperate need of this new work.

"This funding is a big win for Cattai Public School and will allow families to drop students off at school in safety" Ms Preston said.

"This project has been on the wish list for Cattai Public School for more than thirty years. It is amazing how perseverance finally gets results and I want to acknowledge the parents, and P&C members who approached me for assistance and the staff who also engaged with the Department of Education," said Ms Preston.

Minister for Metropolitan Roads Natalie Ward said "The completed road resurfacing works will make a big difference to the families and staff who use the road every day.
